Thank you for sending in your Pension Assessment for 1969. From this I note that you suggest that the whole sum of \$4200 will be found from the Parish--- is this correct?


If you are seeking subsidy from the Diocese, then the amount required should be shown in 1(b), and item 3 should be 25% of the first sub-total.
