- 1) First Missionary trips to Japan with Mrs. Nakayama 1930
 - 2) Missionary trips in B.C., Vancouver Island's points, Prince Rupert and points, Fraser Valley points, Okanagan Valley points. in 1930-42 many times.
 - 3) Once a year from 1929-42 we had three states. province (B.C. Washington, Oregon) Japanese Christian Conference in Vancouver, Seattle and Portland and Rev. Nakayama attended these meetings and preached in several churches.
 - 4) In 1939 there was a big All North America Japanese Christian Gathering - 60 th anniversary of the Japanese Missionaries in North America. After attending this gathering Rev. Nakayama was invited by 30 Churches including Sandiego he visited and preaches at 33 churches
 - 5) In 1943 visited all Japanese interment camps- New Denver Roseberry, Sandon, Kaslo, Greenwood, Tashme etc.
 - 6) Visited almost all places where there were Japanese living in Canada from Coaldale Alberta to Montreal
 - 7) In 1945 Second Missionary trip all through Canada
 - 8) in 1946 The third all Canada Missionary trip
 - 9) In 1947 Received a special travel permit from the U.S. government made an all U.S.A. and Canada Missionary trip 39 cities in U.S.A. and 21 cities in Canada covered from the Pacific to the Atrantic.
 - 0) In 1949 , by the special invitation by The presiding Bishop of Nippon Seikakai ' Holy Catholic Church of Japan , went to Japan and preached 273 times in 10 Diocese from Hokkaido to Kyushu and Okinawa with the audience of more than 1000000. He was the special preacher for the 90 th anniversary of the Protestant Mission in Japan. He preached in Hawaii for 10 days.

 - 3) In 1954 Missionary trip to B.C. and Alberta with Bishop Yashiro and eight other Japanese priests of Japan.

 - 6) With the special invitation from Brasil Episcopal Church wento to Brasil Paraguay and Argentina in 1950 Visited 70 Churches and preached 101 time. Mrs Nakayama accompanied him.
