

Dear community members. The 5-year Healing Fund project is nearing the end of its second year. At the start of Septem-

ber, 2023, our community feedback form (QR code below) will close for responses and a new budget for the following three years will be created. If you or someone you know may be interested in receiving counselling support, an education grant, or community healing and education projects we encourage you to have your voice heard through the community feedback form. The Healing Fund for Japanese Canadians operates three areas for healing support.

- We can cover the cost of counselling up to \$200 per session for survivors of Mr. Nakayama's sexual abuse and to their families.
- We provide post-secondary education grants to family members of survivors, retroactive to June 15, 2015.
- We can fund community healing or education programming, including any project that relates to the sexual abuse history of Mr. Nakayama or to the effects of this widespread abuse.
 Funded programs have included healing circles, book clubs, and writing projects.




